  - Alli requested a vote for executive members in favour of moving forward with setting an official email up. The vote passes.
  - Alli will get in touch with BCLA to set up the email account.
  - We agreed on the following governance:
    - One exec member to check the account regularly (the Chair).
    - All exec members to have access to the account.
    - Annual password refresh.

## 6. New Business

# 7. Continuing Education (Kate/Ioana)

- a. Resume clinic for students interested in academic libraries (Kate & Ioana)
  - This event will be held Thursday, April 11, 2-5pm, SFU Vancouver, room 2945. Ioana and Kate are coordinating.
    - Kate reached out to PLIG, but did not hear back yet, so we are moving forward with an academic libraries focus.
  - Invitation sent to librarians last week. Kate will continue to solicit volunteers.
  - Ioana will be sharing the event with iSchool students.
  - Pub social afterwards -- need to identify a venue, and hope to have students indicate their intention to attend while registering so we have a sense of how many will be coming.
  - Discussion about inviting Lib Tech students as well as MLIS students.
    - Last year, this event ran as a MLIS student pilot. General agreement that we would like to include Lib Tech students.
    - Some concerns about whether librarian volunteers feel confident or able to comment on lib tech hiring practices.
    - Kate and Ioana will look at revising the invitation to include Lib Tech students.
    - Alli can distribute to Langara and UFV, and can reach out to try and recruit Library Technician volunteers.

 Edit March 22, 2019: As per Kate's email to the exec, we will hold off on sharing the event with Langara and UFV students until we have recruited volunteers able to review Lib Tech student CVs.
