Meeting called to order at 7:02pm by Chair, Tamarack Hockin.

Projects & Initiatives Updates

- 1) BCLA Conference 2012 Stephen Karr
 - i) BCLA Sections, Committees, & Interest Groups each have rep on conference planning committee this year; Stephen was selected to represent LTAIG.
 - ii) Conference will be May 10-12, 2012, at Sheraton Vancouver Airport in Richmond. Theme will be "License to Read." There will be 27-35 sessions. Committee is working on selection criteria.
 - iii) Session reserved for speed mentoring; modelled on LTAIG's session at UFV. Other reserved sessions: Tradeshow Orientation, Libraries & Literacy, Author Talks, Great Debate
 - iv) There will be no association-wide pre-conference, so LTAIG could organize its own pre-conference sessions. Stephen supports this if we can keep cost low and start planning soon. Richmond Public Library will offer space for SCIG sessions.
 - v) Further details will be announced via the listserv, Facebook, and Twitter, and the discussion forum.
- 2) LTAIG Blog Heather Duff
 - i) Two new contributors have joined the blog: Phil Menger and Grace Ju.
 - ii) Posts, suggestions & feedback welcome. Working on new graphics.
- 3) Communications Stephen Karr
 - i) Website: made menus more efficient, added event pictures, and added & edited pages. Planning list of online reference tools in various subject areas.
 - ii) *Proboards Discussion Forum*: active about 15 months so far; 45 members plus many guests, 155 topics, 2017 posts; many people find it through listserv.
 - iii) Facebook Group: active over 2 years so far; 118 members; primarily announcing events; high number of member contributions on Wall. Upgrade by Facebook means members can now chat, but people must request to join the Group and can't message members directly. Questions could be posted to Group to promote response.
 - iv) Twitter: 108 followers, 90 tweets; used to announce events and retweet relevant tweets by others.
 - v) Linkedin Group: just formed open group; 11 members already; members can post anything, but non-members must submit discussions and comments for approval.

- 4) Salary Survey Sandra Cole
 - i) Survey site is now active; link sent to LTAIG listserv, Facebook group and blog plus other listservs; over 100 replies so far. Closes in 1 month; report should be done month later.

- 5) Mentoring Tamarack Hockin
 - i) Next intake shortly; applications on website in few days; will sign up mentees & mentors through November.
 - ii) BCLA will start association-wide program modelled on LTAIG's program in 2012; Tamarack helping with launch; LTAIG program will join BCLA's.
 - iii) Speed mentoring session very likely in 2012 BCLA conference
- 6) Dialogue Tamarack Hockin
 - a) Pre-dialogue questionnaire had good response from members; report on LTAIG website.
 - b) Dialogue session June 8, 2011 re what people want from group; participants from all over province; <u>final</u> <u>report on website</u>; biggest issues were relevant professional development, networking & advocacy for library technicians & assistants (LTAs).
 - c) This AGM informed by the dialogue, especially scope & positions; trying to spread work more widely.

Member question: Is the same content on all LTAIG communications platforms (ex. Blog, Facebook, etc.)?

- LTAIG does try to duplicate announcements across platforms. Suggestion to promote issues on listserv then have actual discussions about issues on forum.
- 6) Petition for Section Status Stephen Karr for Sandra Cole
 - a) Purpose = become Section for greater voice, especially seat on BCLA executive
 - b) Need successful petition to put on BCLA AGM agenda; all signers must be individual BCLA members, not institutional; at least 10% of BCLA membership must sign and signers must be individual members in good standing @ time of AGM; . Then ¾ of BCLA AGM attendees must vote for it to pass.
 - c) First attempt started at 2010 BCLA AGM for submission to 2011 AGM; had enough signers (99) but not enough of them were individual members in good standing (66).
 - d) Started second attempt right away at 2011 BCLA AGM; petition currently has over 80 signatures. Plan to step up petition drive in January, then put on agenda at 2012 BCLA AGM.

- e) Publications Liaison New position; will coordinate with BCLA Browser and other LTA-relevant publications; solicit articles, write articles, track deadlines, etc. Volunteer can define scope and time commitment.

- f) Marketing/Design Coordinator New position; volunteer can define scope & time commitment; maybe work on logo and package for program grads; graphic design background or interest would help.

- 2) Salary Survey Sandra Cole and Vaunda Dumont have distributed survey and will tabulate results; next survey in 2 years.
- 3) Continuing Education Committee Shanna Meunier announces workshops, conferences, and courses on forum and listserv.

- 4) Mentoring Committee Tamarack Hockin recruits and matches participants plus publicizes and administers program.

- 5) Careers Coordinator new position; watches for LTA-relevant job postings and sends them to listserv.

- 6) Accreditation and Credentialing Liaison New position; will keep members informed on topic, inspire and facilitate discussion, and liaise with related projects.

- a) Christina Neigel developing proposal to CLA for accreditation of English-speaking Library Technician programs in Canada. Accreditation would check that a program has met standards set by governing organization, whereas credentialing involves individuals meeting standards. Programs would be evaluated and vetted to ensure their grads have certain competencies. Not trying to define strict roles for LTAs vs. Librarians. CLA has Guidelines for Education of Library Technicians but no evaluation process. Christina is asking LTA associations for letter of support re interest in project; Ontario (OALT) has given letter already.
- b) The Partnership is doing pilot project of continuing education credentialing.
