Interesting RA tidbits:

- Jen: upcoming SLAIS event called Bookish Bloodshed, lunch-time RA event for kids books, students in teams. If successful, might do another for adult books.
- > Chloe brought a couple "Year of Reading" pamphlets from Seattle library to show us
- Barbara is thinking about the book club experience, capturing the transformative stories of reading in people's lives, referenced <u>Ian Brown's series in the Globe & Mail on the role of reading.</u>
- Claire: starting shelf-talkers program at all branches, 25 shelf-talkers per branch
- > Tara is experimenting with badges for staff, and is developing an RA badge for release in 2016
- Winifred mentioned the YALSA app, <u>Teen Book Finder</u>
- Shelley: it's the 400th anniversary of Shakespeare's birth/death, Dr. Brenna Gray is giving a library talk in April, and they'll be screening some films. VPL is doing a talk and preview for Bard on the Beach (April 26)
