 - o Classes generally full, summer early lit course is at capacity.
 - Ran 5-week Zoom workshop on story times in March, to give students similar
 Pro-D opportunities to professionals; sessions were also full
 - All content is on Storytimes by Tess (Wordpress blog); those outside iSchool can join future sessions (JM: Opportunity for paraprofessionals)
 - Hoping to run again in summer, with approval from iSchool Director; may eventually do face-to-face sessions, but would consider continuing online
 - Once summer session booked, ST will boost on social media
