- a. Pub Night (Ryan)
  - We had excellent turn-out at the April Pub Night! Many people had also attended the CV Clinic beforehand. The format of hosting a smaller event followed by a pub night worked very well.
  - One of the participants let us know about the <u>Journal Club Network</u>, which may of interest for future Education Coordinators who organize Pub Nights.
- b. Keeping it ReAL 2018 (Ali M)
  - The date for the next Keeping it ReAL will be Friday Oct 26, 2018 at UVic Library.
  - There is an upcoming meeting of the planning committee on Tues May 8. The
    Continuing Education Coordinators will stay on the planning committee until they
    can facilitate a warm hand-off to the incoming exec members (provided the
    incoming members want to continue working on this project).
  - Ali M also noted that the Continuing Education Coordinators have been discussing strategies for managing workload among themselves for BCALS activities and events (for example, having one Coordinator sitting on the Keeping it ReAL committee while the others facilitate BCALS events). They will share their experiences with the incoming Coordinators.
- c. Libraries and Publishing in BC (Ali M)
  - The workshop is called Library-Based Publishing Initiative. Registration is now open! Ali M is one of the coordinators though this event is not specifically associated with BCALS.
  - It will take place on Wed May 9 10:30-2:30 at KPU Richmond (a 15 min walk from the BCLA AGM location).
- d. Student CV Clinic (Ali M)
  - This event was very successful! Ali M shared that we had 15 student participants, and that she had a great response from librarians who were interested in participating in mentorship activities that have a smaller time commitment (some expressed interest who were unable to attend that particular session).
    - We collected feedback from students. They overall gave very positive feedback and would recommend the experience to other students. They also offered some areas to improve.
    - Future directions: this could be an opportunity for partnership with the Public Library Interest Group.
    - Ali M will share the students' feedback with the exec.
