- a. Any past/future activities to report on:
 - i. Sunni, BC ELN: Appreciation for the Winter Event. BC ELN's purpose is to help post-secondary libraries in BC equitably meet informational needs of students, educators, researchers. Funded by the Ministry of Advanced Skills, Education and Training. Consortial licensing of e-resources (demanding rates lower than any individual library could get); collaborative services (coordinating services that partner libraries can use, e.g. AskAway, WriteAway, Arca digital repository, sharing costs across institutions); fostering partnerships (increasing opportunities, e.g. BC History Digitization Program supporting applicants, trying to level the playing field by supporting smaller libraries). New Strategic Plan and related goals for services to be launched soon. Visit bceln.ca for more information.
 - ii. Alli, Langara College: Langara Library Director position is currently posted. Student Success initiatives including peer support and supports for students who have left and are returning are being given a new home in an Academic Success Centre to improve support for these programs. Langara has a new Director of Indigenous Education, Graeme Joseph.
 - iii. David, Alexander College: Moving to new ILS.
 - iv. Adena and Jenna, SFU: New Associate Dean of Libraries for Collections and Content Strategy, Mar González Palacios. New Associate Dean of Libraries for Academic Engagement, Ebony Magnus, starting in new year. SFU Library Strategic Plan was refreshed this year. Bennett branch closed until mid next week due to asbestos issues but Fraser and Belzberg branches are open.
