- Finance update: Annette and Sarah met. Approximately \$45,000 dollars in FNIG account. BCLA supports the spending of these funds as per original grant and FNIG interests:
  - New library technician scholarship for library technician. BCLA will administer for FNIG.

**TO DO:** Determine a name of the scholarship, blurb, who it will be for, how much will be awarded. Tentatively ball parked \$20,000. Process to be completed in January/ February 2015 for possible awarding at 2015 BCLA conference.

**TO DO:** working group to investigate and deliver proposal for FNIG on best options and wording for scholarship.

Online course/modules Community Libraries Training Program (CLTP) – Moodle course. Langara offers a very similar version of the program. Could spend money on this if we want to. Who owns the copyright? BCLA owns copyright and is going to write letter giving the ok for future development to FNIG. BCLA prefers to have any future contract/ salary money administered by another body, but will send over the agreed on lump sum.

**TO DO:** Need to strike a working group.

- Provincial wide survey (this may connect to the Write to Read Project). BCLA is interested in helping us fundraise for this to expand survey work. New money we bring in for this will need to have admin costs discussed with BCLA. FNIG to pursue in near future, but tabled until scholarship/course are worked on.
