

Safety - Key Points to Remember

Key Points to Remember (from Dave King, OH&S Officer)

- Maintain social distance (reach out and don't touch someone) – from both patrons and other staff
- Wash hands a lot
- Do not touch your face
- Cough in to your elbow or sleeve
- Communicate clearly expectations of public
- Communicate clearly to patron the roles of staff
- When you receive a request from patron, stop, and then act from a distance
- Approach the patron workstation only if they have moved behind the line (stanchion)
- When applying QUAT often, minimize exposure by using eyewear and/or mask. Apply product downwind (i.e. in such a way that you are moving away from the application area, as opposed to into the application area)
- If patrons are not following social distancing expectations, clearly identify that they “follow the expectations or leave” – 1 warning only and then contact Security
- Security not to approach individuals without PPE
- Keep doors open
- Use PPE (gloves) to remove and sanitize patron workstations at end of session
- Use PPE (gloves) to sanitize your workstation at beginning and end of day with quat solution
- Other PPE (masks and/or face shields) are provided. Use it as you wish.

- Remove the hazard before you think of PPE (social distance vs mask)
- Elimination, Substitution, Engineering, Administration, PPE. In that order.
