


Al isn't just one technology!

Al Concerns: Deep Fakes





The Future of Al


Al Transparency deals with concepts such as explainable AI (XAI): Understanding how data predictions and algorithms are produced help people to understand the influence of decisions made.











How often are you using AI in your personal life?





Understanding AI leads to faster productivity and more career opportunities.




Al Importance: Social Benefits



Navigating Vendor Al Integration

- What's the track record and expertise of vendor?
- What type of support and training are provided?
- What's the ROI?
- Does it solve your specific problem & is it scalable?
- How does the vendor handle data privacy?
- What security measures are in place?
- Does it integrate seamless with your current tech stack? (software, databases, API's)
- Can you customize the solution?
- Has it been tested for bias?
- Does the vendor provide transparency around training data?
- Can the vendor explain how AI makes decisions?
- How's the performance and accuracy?
- Who will own the Al's systems output?
- Are there any societal impacts?

- Develop rubric to evaluate tools

Collect Data

- What are staff using and why?
- What would people like to use?

- Create a governance structure
- Create an Al Policy

Evaluate

- Vendor evaluation
- Use Case Evaluation

Launch

- Staff training
- Tools to be used
- Patron training
