 - o In past, students had regular YAACS meetings; can promote YAACS website and info, encourage joining listservs, etc. (SB)
 - o iSchool students can attend YAACS meetings (ML and SB)
 - On-campus workshops not currently possible but could still host workshops,
 some students might be willing to share experience (TP); TP and RW can help

Red Cedar Book Award (Marilyn MacPherson VPL)

- New Strategic Plan, new website (September or mid-October); responding to new issues such as privacy, sharing content, etc.; have looked at OLA's Forest of Reading and contacted YRCA organizations across province to discuss changes
- Goals include liaising more with First Nations Schools Association, extending into more rural communities, expanding representation beyond public libraries and librarians,

 - PL will ask if can use WVML account for workshops, JM will ask VPL; PL and JM will coordinate
